TLSCC 2023 - Checklist for Environmental Health

- 1) Ten individuals will need to complete the Texas food handler certification. These individuals will act as marshals or captains for their areas during the duration of the event.
 - 2) Provide a list of all registered cooks to the City so that temporary food permits can be issued. The information should include the cook's name, phone number, mailing address, email, and food products used. To complete the permits in time for the event, the cooks' information should be submitted as soon as possible or on a weekly basis to health@seguintexas.gov
 - 3) At registration, a Self-Inspection Checklist and Acknowledgement Form will be included in the welcome packets. This form will require the signature of each cook. Forms will be collected at the initial morning inspection.
 - 4) The City will have two health officials on site while the chili is being cooked so they can inspect and watch for any hazards.
 - 5) The City will cover the cost for each temporary food permit issued.
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
